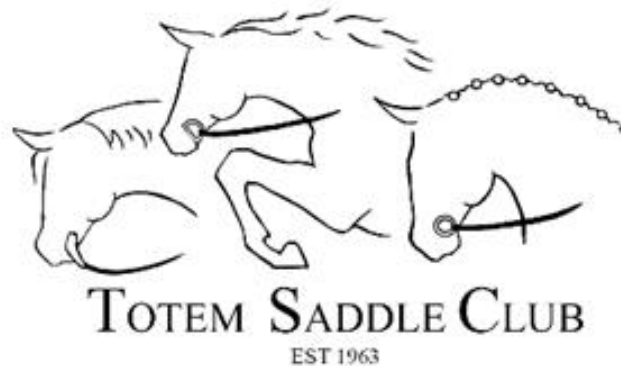

GENERAL INFORMATION:

*Show will follow HCBC rules unless otherwise posted.

1. Refunds will not be provided without a Veterinary / Doctors note.
2. All riders should be in full show attire, including an ASTM approved riding helmet. Placings may be affected for unclean attire / horse.
3. Competition number must be on the riders back or saddle pad when competing. Bridle tags are considered optional.
4. Totem Saddle Club reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any classes.
5. Junior riders may not show stallion.
6. Totem Saddle Club reserves the right to remove those participating in unsafe or abusive behaviour off of the premises.
7. Parking only in designated parking areas.
8. TSC is not responsible for any lost or stolen items
9. Overnight camping and stall use is welcome at a charge of \$15 for stalls. A \$25 stall deposit is required and will be returned to competitor after presentation of a clean stall to one of the organizers.
10. All dogs on the grounds must be leashed. Any person with loose dogs will be asked to leave
11. Dressage start times will be posted to the Facebook event page.
12. Entries will not be accepted without FULL payment
13. Post entries will be accepted with an additional \$5/class fee.
14. Age of Riders: As of January 1 of current year.
Youth: open to riders up to 18 years of age
Senior: 19 years and older

STAKES CLASS PRIZE MONEY PAYOUTS: Payouts 1st = 50%, 2nd = 30%, 3rd = 20%

DRESSAGE HIGHPOINT: Competitors may ride 3 consecutive tests (may include freestyle). HP will be awarded to a youth and a senior based on the average of the 3 scores.

HUNTER & JUMPER HIGHPOINT: The highest accumulation of points from 4 classes in 2 divisional heights, to be awarded to a youth and a senior. (Trotting poles do not count towards high point)

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

HUNTER: To be judged on the horse's manners, ways of going, and style of jumping. Conformation is not considered.

HUNTER EQUITATION: To be judged on the rider.

WELCOME JUMPER: Table A Speed. Faults are penalized by points, and the rounds are against the clock.

MATCH THE CLOCK: Riders must clear the course at the posted optimum time allowed with no faults. Faults are penalized by points

POWER AND SPEED: The rider must clear the first few jumps clear (power), then proceed to the speed portion of the course which is timed.

GAMBLERS CHOICE: You have 60 seconds to jump as many jumps as you can, each jump will have an assigned point. Jumps may only be jumped once in each direction. No punishment for refusals, no points awarded for an obstacle knocked down. If the signal sounds at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped.

An audible signal declares start and the finish of the round.

After the audible signal the rider must then cross the finish line, at this time the "Joker" fence may be attempted once. It is worth 200 points, but caution if you have a refusal or the rail falls 200 points will be deducted from your total. The joker fence may be set up to 6" higher than the course height.

DRESSAGE

Riders may ride up to 3 consecutive tests (which may include freestyle)
